You know me! You know my calling to travel to difficult areas where pain and confusion often reign as a result of the epidemic existence of rape and the HIV+ virus. I am going again to Goma, DRC (Democratic Republic of Congo) to teach the facts about HIV for both prevention and to those already infected, as well as spread HOPE as I share the message of God's love and healing.

It is on behalf of the people of Congo that I reach out to you today. In Congo, very few have HIV meds; most of them have no hope and can only face death. I have been to Congo four times in my life. Each trip is rich and full of stories and answers to prayer. Now for my 5th trip, I am going to work with "He Intends Victory" (H.I.V.), which is a U.S.-based, nonprofit, who works internationally. I have been honored to be on their board for nearly 20 years.

Over 12 years ago, He Intends Victory started an outreach in Goma, DRC. We financed hair salons and other micro enterprises. Now we want to re-empower the HIV+ women so they can make a living for themselves and their children. I will address hundreds who are sick in the hospitals, and we have a core group of over 40 HIV/AIDS widows for whom I will be praying for inner healing to assist them with the immense trauma they have had to endure. I have seen God's healing touch in the past and I know that He will show up again every time He is invited; please pray with me and those whom God touches will encounter His love in powerful ways, thanks to many of you who will be praying for this ministry. I covet your prayers.

I have prayed about my expenses and God has given me a goal of raising \$2,000 for travel costs to include transportation while in Goma so I can visit those that are home bound and speak at their churches. Also, I will need an interpreter so that I can communicate with the family member and so they can understand my prayers over them.

Added donations to H.I.V. will go towards new small business loans the help provide employment. This program of "Microfinance" has been proven very effective in areas of high unemployment like Goma.

I ask that you pray about donating to my trip and helping me to help the people in Goma that struggle daily with a disease that kills over 1800 month in their region alone. I know that not everyone can go, but everyone has the opportunity to participate by giving.
